# VII. Course Objectives

- 1. To create effective and efficient Administrative Professionals by developing career specific skills
- 2. To impart knowledge in multidisciplinary and multi dimensional aspects related with healthcare management, hospital planning, human resource management, marketing (promotions), finance, materials management, quality control, hospital policies, procedures, rules, regulations, values of professional ethics etc
- 3. To create the ability to identify the administrative issues and analyze various factors to overcome healthcare challenges with the support of quantitative techniques

- 4. To empower students in evaluating performance of hospital services by ensuring optimum use of available resources
- 5. To encourage students to develop flair for research and innovations in the field of healthcare administration

#### VIII.Eligibility for admission

- 1. Candidates shall have any degree from any recognized university in the country established by law with a minimum of 50% marks.
- 2. Usual relaxation of marks for SC/ST/SEBC candidates as per government guidelines shall be permitted. Registration with the respective statutory councils, wherever it is insisted by the KUHS will be mandatory.
- 3. Candidate shall pass Aptitude Assessment test being conducted

#### IX. Seat distribution

- a. Total number of seats 20
- b. Total number of seats available for admission in accordance with this prospectus is 20, distributed among the following categories

#### Notes:

- 1. Qualified medical graduate means candidates who passed MBBS, BDS, BHMS, or similar course and obtained degree certificate from any university established under law in India.
- Qualified nursing / allied health science graduate means candidates who passed BSc Nursing, BPT, B.Pharm or similar course with minimum course duration of four years and obtained degree certificate from any university established under law in India.
- 3. Open merit seats are open to all categories of eligible applicants subject to IX (6).
- Two seats out of the open merit seats will be allotted to candidates who belong to 'Christian Community'. Certificates from the respective revenue authority shall be produced to prove the claim.
- 5. Reservation to SC/ST and other backward communities are available as per Government norms
- 6. Unfilled seats in any of the above reservation categories including reservation to 'Christian', shall be reverted to open merit.
- 7. For inclusion under a particular category, decision of the management shall be final.

#### X. Application procedure

Prospectus can be downloaded from the website <u>www.mosciahs.edu.in</u>. Applications should be only through online. All particulars in the online application form should be entered by the candidate. Name should be entered as per the SSLC / +2 certificates. Those who are awaiting the results shall enter the average percentage of the available results. Candidates who have appeared for the final year/semester examination of the qualifying degree may also apply, but must be able to produce the credentials at least 3 days before the date specified for publication of rank list & first allotment list. Information furnished thereafter will not be entertained. All communications in respect of the admission procedure will be through the website <u>www.mosciahs.edu.in</u> Candidates are advised to visit the website regularly. Incomplete online applications in any respect will not be considered.

Print out of filled in application form should be sent to the address mentioned in clause XI(1) and it should be accompanied by self attested copies of mark statements of the qualifying examination, 10<sup>th</sup> standard, Plus Two Certificate, Degree Mark List, Degree Certificate, Conduct Certificate, Migration Certificate (If applicable), Eligibility Certificate from KUHS (If applicable), Proof for reservation (If applicable), copy of Adhar card and recent photograph.

Candidates are advised not to enclose any original certificates along with the application form.

#### XI. Instructions to the candidate

- 1. Candidate should upload his/her recent passport size photograph of 50 KB and signature of 20KB (jpg format) in online application form.
- Print out of filled in application form shall be sent to The Principal, MOSC Institute of Allied Health Sciences, MOSC Medical College Hospital, Kolenchery, Kerala 682311 by registered post or can be submitted in person to the office of Principal, MOSC Institute of Allied Health Sciences.
- 3. The Institution will not be responsible for any postal delay or loss in transit.
- 4. Last date for online submission of application is 20/08/2020.
- 5. Rank list of eligible candidates will be published on the website www.mosciahs.edu.in

- 6. Letters or certificates enabling to obtain any bank loan or financial assistance will be issued only after 3 working days of submission of application for the same.
- 7. Hostel and mess facility will be available for students.
- 8. The Management will have the right to deny admission to any applicant; if it is found that their character and antecedents are found to be questionable on genuine grounds. In such cases, the reason for the same will be recorded and communicated.

# XII. Procedure of selection

Aptitude assessment test will be conducted with due notification in the official website to assess the flair of students for health management studies and candidate shall pass in this test to be considered for selection. The admission will be on the basis of inter-se merit obtained in the qualifying examination (degree) subjected to normalization process from the list of candidates applied.

The marks obtained in the qualifying examination will be subjected to normalization process as explained below.

- 1. This process will be done based on the highest aggregate mark in each stream obtained by candidates who apply pursuant to this prospectus.
- 2. For the purpose of normalization process, all candidates will be divided into the following six streams
  - a. Medical, b. Nursing, c. Engineering, d. Arts, e. Science and f. commerce
- 3. The aggregate marks obtained by the candidates in the qualifying examination of a particular stream shall be equated with the aggregate marks obtained by other candidates in the qualifying examination of other streams.

Explanation: Under the process of normalization, the highest aggregate mark obtained by a candidate in each stream shall be equated to the highest aggregate mark obtained by a candidate among all streams and the relative marks of other candidates in each particular stream shall be determined accordingly.

4. Notwithstanding any lawful change in marks obtained by a candidate or receipt of additional applications due to extension of 'last date for submitting the application' after the publication of rank list, the normalization Rules once established shall not be changed.

# XIII. Admission

All original certificates/documents to be submitted at the time of admission Selected candidates shall take admission at the appointed time and date after paying the tuition fee and other fees to be paid, failing which the offer of admission shall stand cancelled.
